Metal Fencing Stolen from ODOT Highway Job



Narrative

Oregon State Police Trooper Bechtel reports to CICIP that on October 28, 2013, the ODOT Estacada Section reported that metal fencing used to keep falling rocks off the highway had been taken from SR 224 near milepost 36.5. The fence is made of two inch square metal tube framing and chain link fencing. Each section is 12.5 feet long and 45 inches tall. Pictures are attached.

Approximately 20 sections of fencing are valued at \$185.00 each have been stolen. This is a loss of approximately \$3700 in material. This is Oregon State Police Case # SP13-025109.
